





Cable Modem




HOW TO CONNECT YOUR CABLE MODEM

After a cable connection has been installed in your home (remotely or physically), please follow these instructions to connect your cable modem:

- Connect the **Cable Modem** to the coaxial jack on the wall using a **Coaxial Cable**.
 - (There may be a coaxial jack on the wall that you need to plug a cable into or the coaxial cable will be coming directly out of the wall.)
- Connect the **Cable Modem** to a power outlet using the **Modem Power Adapter** provided. If the device does not power on, look for a power button. Please ensure that you use the correct power adapter.
- Your modem will automatically download the proper configuration files. Please wait a few minutes for this step to complete. When complete, the online light on the modem will turn solid green and stay this way.
- Connect your devices to the internet by plugging one end of the ethernet cable into an ethernet port on the modem then plugging the other end into the ethernet port on the device.

If you have your own WiFi Router, plug it into the modem using the ethernet cable. You will need to use your own Router if you require a WiFi signal to connect devices wirelessly.

Note: Make sure the modem has been connected in the correct order. If you are still having trouble: Unplug the modem and wait 10 seconds. Reconnect the modem again starting at **Step 1**.
